


CEPD meeting Monday

Property damaged? Let the property appraiser know

FROM THE LEE COUNTY PROPERTY APPRAISER:

For those of you that were impacted by the hurricane and have hurricane damage, you may tell us about your property damage by using this hurricane reporting link. You may also directly upload photos and other information here.

As to the taxable valuation of property in Lee County, you can connect with our office here to submit information about the damage your property sustained in the hurricane. At the least, this information will help our office make adjustments to the property record in advance of the January 1, 2023 tax year. Additionally, after previous historic hurricanes, the State of Florida has passed retroactive tax breaks of varying degrees. If that occurs again, this information will also be used in determining which properties qualify under the standards adopted by the Legislature, if any.
