

## Sanibel update

#### FROM CITY OF SANIBEL:

According to the Tuesday night update, the City of Sanibel will allow deliveries to island residences with the proper paperwork identifying the address and owner. (This would be for major items such as appliances, etc.) We have not been able to confirm this with city officials, and we understand this does not apply (yet) to Amazon deliveries (among others).

**Passes available**: The City of Sanibel announced that Hurricane Passes will be issued on Friday, Nov. 11, from 8:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. at the City's temporary location at 7910 Summerlin Lakes Drive.

Due to Hurricane Nicole, the City suspended Hurricane Pass issuance on Thursday, Nov. 10. The City is closed on Nov. 11 to honor and observe Veteran's Day. However, a small group of staff will be at the temporary location to issue Hurricane Passes as a make-up day from the Hurricane Nicole closure.

Hurricane Pass issuance will resume normal operations on Monday, Nov. 14, 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., (closed for lunch 12 p.m. to 1 p.m.) Monday through Friday at 7910 Summerlin Lakes Drive.

Free Health Clinic Available on Sanibel: A partnership between the Lee County Medical Society, Lee EMS, and Broward County Medical Corp has established a FREE medical clinic on Sanibel.

Beginning Monday, Nov. 14, the clinic will operate from a white trailer located in front of the Sanibel Fire Station on Palm Ridge. The hours are generally 8 am-4 pm, Monday through Friday, depending on travel times to the island.

Services offered by volunteer physicians include free flu shots (including the vaccine for those aged 65+), tetanus shots, wound care, and assessment and treatment of respiratory issues like cough, flu, pneumonia, and bronchitis.
