

Sanibel Causeway emergency restoration

FROM FLORIDA DOT:

As a part of the Florida Department of Transportation's (FDOT) Emergency Restoration of the Sanibel Causeway, crews continue work on McGregor Boulevard and the Sanibel Causeway from Port Comfort Road to Sanibel Island. Please note that the contractor has scheduled **OVERNIGHT LANE CLOSURES** on **MONDAY, APRIL 10**.

- The causeway islands surrounding the temporary roadway are an active work zone and are currently closed for public access.
- Motorists should expect lane closures on the causeway during overnight hours on **Monday, April 10**, from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. for crews to repair asphalt in multiple locations on the bridge approaches. Two-way traffic will be maintained.
- Crews continue driving sheet pile around the causeway islands.
- Crews continue earthwork on the causeway islands.
- Bicyclists are encouraged to utilize another mode of transportation to travel the causeway.
- Pedestrians are not permitted on the Sanibel Causeway.
- Many oversized vehicles are crossing the causeway to assist with recovery efforts on the island. Please be patient as travel may be slower than usual.
- MOTORISTS ARE REMINDED TO OBEY THE POSTED SPEED LIMIT OF 20 MPH.
- Please use caution and watch for workers and construction vehicles entering and leaving the roadway.
